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## Beavers Winter Long Course Meet Incorporating eThekweni Age Group 5 and eThekweni level 1 gala 5.

**Friday 18th August – Sunday 20th August 2017  
Venue Kings Park Indoor Pool**

It is once again our privilege to invite you all to the Beavers Winter Championships.

Due to the precinct around Kings Park Pool being closed for our original gala dates, we have moved our gala to the weekend of the Age Group Program 5 & Level 1 Program 5, incorporating all the events scheduled to be swum at these events.

This gala will be recognized as an Official Age Group Gala and Level 1 Program Gala.

- The meet is open to all Level of swimmers, Level 1 swimmers may only compete in events to 1-10, on Sunday the 20<sup>th</sup> August.
- The swimmers age is determined by their age on the 18<sup>th</sup> August 2017.
- The meet will be recognized and be run in accordance with KZNA, SSA & FINA Age Group Rules.
- The competition will be swum using 10 lanes. The one start rule will be in effect.
- All Swimmers must be registered with SSA. A provincial clearance to be submitted with “out of Province” entries.
- Swimmers may enter all events in their age group as well as any open event on condition they do not compete in the same event in their age group. Swimmers will only score points in their age group.
- Swimmers entering the 1500 Free must have a Level 3 - 200 Free qualifying time.
- All events will be swum as Timed Finals.
- The following age groups will compete: 8 & under; 9/10 yrs; 11/12 yrs; 13/14 yrs and 15 & Over.
- Medals will only be awarded for the 50m events in the Level1 competition.
- Medals for Level 2 & above swimmers will be awarded in each of the events on the program.
- Points will be scored as follows: 12, 10, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, points will not be awarded for the Level 1 events.
- The swim meet will be scored and competed on a club basis and the winning club will receive a trophy.
- A trophy will be presented to the:
  - o Best Overall Club
  - o Best Female at Champs
  - o Best Male at Champs
  - o Best Female Swimmer with a Disability
  - o Best Male Swimmer with a Disability

The above will be based on highest points scored.

## Officials

All technical officials to be correctly attired.

o White top and navy blue longs, shorts or skirts and predominantly white closed shoes.

It is the responsibility of the CLUB to ensure that their required number of officials submitted report for duty.

CLUBS are accountable to find a replacement if a given official does not report for duty.

CLUBS will be fined if the required number of officials does not do duty on that day.

Official duty roster must be submitted with gala entries, if not, then gala entries will not be captured.

Officials are classified as Judges or Time keepers;

o 1-5 swimmers min 1 official.

o 6-10 swimmers min 2 officials.

o 11-20 swimmers min 3 officials.

o 21-30 swimmers min 4 officials.

o 31 + swimmers min 5 officials.

Officials must be qualified and registered failing which the following fines will be imposed:

o Un Qualified R100.00

o Un Registered R100.00

o No Show R200.00

All Managers/coaches packs can be collected at the front gate on the 18 August 2017.

There are no qualifying times for these championships.

Scratching's will not incur a fine.

Electronic Timing will be used.

Manual entries must be faxed to 031 464 4695. Hard copies to be included with your entries as well as proof of payment, list of timekeepers and clearance for out of province swimmers.

Entries must be done through Club Gala Secretaries and not by individual club members.

The closing date for entries is **Thursday 10th August 2017**. Please confirm entries have been received by requesting a "read receipt" with emailed entries or by calling 031 464 6796 between 08h00 and 16h00. Only gala secretaries are to confirm entries.
